
The Transcribed Gypsy Jazz Chordbook



Project goal

This TGJC project's main goal is to offer musicians accurate gypsy jazz chord charts transcribed from Django Reinhardt recordings. The TGJC is a community project: transcribers participate by suggesting corrections, making the document even more reliable.

Chord notations

- Embellishments are indicated only if necessary. Major chords are usually played M, or 6, or 69 and rarely Maj7. It's up to you.
- "m" and "m7" are different chord qualities. Chords written "m" can usually be played "m6" but not often "m7" in gypsy jazz. Also, try to often play plain minor chords instead of m7 or m6 chords.
- Some chords are purposely written to catch musicians attention and to make them sound more like the original songs (the second chord of "Dinette" being a good example)
- Minor chords are notated "m", Maj7 chords are notated Δ and m7b5 are notated \emptyset . Other notations are possible, but I find these compact and easily readable.
- Some parameters like the size of the characters are not customizable. They are set by default in the iRealPro App. The author of this document is in no way responsible if a "Db9" chord is played D7b9 instead of Db79 during a show o_0
- Some of the chords commonly played today were never played in the original recordings. I chose not to indicate them, except for exceptions (F7 on Django's Tiger for example).

Bass Notes

- Bass notes are indicated for important basslines or for tunes that need them to sound good (Speevy, Black and White,...)
- It is pretty common for the bass player not to play the root on the first beat, in order to prioritize the beauty of the bassline, like Eb G7/D in Georgia on my Mind. This is not often indicated in these charts, to make them more readable. G Bb° D7/A D7 is another very common example, being written G Bb° D7 D7.
- With the same readability goal, some common bass movement like the one in the "cadence christophe" C C7/E F F#° C/G are usually not indicated.

Chord variations

- Each song is transcribed in different versions and not only on the head. Chords can vary from one version to another, and they are usually written as "alternate chords".
- When a choice had to be made between various options, the one who was chosen was the one reflecting best the artistic choices of Django (according to the transcriber).
- Some "clichés" chord variations are not written as they are up to the musicians. For example, the very common ½ step chromatic shift in the years 35-40 (F7 E7 F7 in Hot Lips or The Sheik Of Araby) or the Am Am∆ Am7 Am6 in waltzes (bar 17-20).

Readability

- Chords are notated with as little characters as possible to optimize the readability, which is key for live situations (especially with smartphones).
- Repetitions signs like "%" are used as much as possible, for readability purposes but also to help musicians get their sight off the chart.

Community

- Even if this document is initially created by a single person (Martin Gioani), its purpose is to be modified through the suggestions of its users, to create a more reliable, accurate and renown document.
- Every improvement of this document will be listed at the end of this document. Thank you so much for participating!
